RE: Notice of New Extended Health Care, Dental & Travel Plans Available starting May 1st, 2024

Extended Health Care (EHC) Plan

 - Members can join the EHC Plan during the open enrolment period or within 60 days of terminating group insurance coverage without providing medical evidence of insurability.
 - Members without group coverage or those applying for EHC coverage outside the enrolment period will require evidence of insurability.
- There are multiple plan options available. Members can also purchase EHC Plans to supplement their existing coverage and enjoy enhanced coverage and maximums.

Prestige Travel Insurance provides:

- Comprehensive travel insurance which includes emergency medical coverage, trip cancellation, interruption, & delay¹ coverage, and baggage & personal effects benefits.
- Unlimited number of trips outside of Canada of up to 62 or 93 days, depending on your Base Plan Selection.
- Unlimited number of trips within Canada of any duration.²
- Coverage can be purchased regardless of age or health status – no medical questionnaire required.
- Coverage for eligible sudden and unforeseen circumstances.
